The Master in Yacht Design, promoted by the Faculty of Design, POLI.Design Consortium of the Politecnico di Milano, and carried out in collaboration with the University of the Studies of Genova, supplies the cultural and technical instruments in order to manage the planning and the constructive distance of a boat, sail and motor, from the project brief until the definition of the general plans, to the hydrostatic and hydrofoil calculations, to the preparation of the interior ones, the deck and the board equipments, to the system equipment, the production in shipyard and the central of its executive parts. Such skills allow to satisfy the strong professional vocation that the nautical field expresses currently, both about the required skills to the planning of yachts, its members and accessories, and about the management of the several steps of the production process.

### CONTENTS

The educational programme is articulated in theoretical lessons, practices, technical and planning laboratories mainly in the following units:

- Design and Representation
- Naval Architecture
- Shipbuilding
- Onboard systems and propulsion instruments
- Interiors
- Planning of components and accessories
- Empowerment

### WHO IS FOR?

The Master Course in Yacht Design is intended for candidates in possession of the title of bachelor, university diploma or specialization mostly in architecture, engineering, industrial design and in economic subjects.

### DURATION AND DIPLOMA

Master Course consists of 480 hours spent in the classroom (3 days per week) and 392 hours spent on internship at a company. The educational development also includes an operating experience lasting three months in companies, shipyards and professional offices. After passing the final test, the master's Diploma will be awarded by the Politecnico di Milano. The Master entitles the participants 60 credits ICFU issued by the Politecnico, and acknowledged in all Europe. Lessons will be held at Polidesign, Consortium of the Politecnico of Milano, Via Durando, 38/A, Milan, Italy.

### ADMISSION

Admission to the master is based on an evaluation of the applicant resume and an individual interview. Knowledge of Italian is considered a fundamental requirement. To take part to the selection process, candidates should send their curriculum vitae to:
