HOW TO REQUEST

The application for scholarships must be made by email to the address formazione@polidesign.net and confirmed during the interview with the Master's Department.

Scholarships are only available to those who will apply for selection and participation in the Masters course of COLOR DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY, Level I, for year 2018/2019 as per Decree No. 1948 Prot. No. 33515 Date 20.04.2017.

ASSIGNMENT CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS

Scholarships will be awarded until they are assigned completely, in chronological order of registration. This order will take into account the date of payment of the deposit amounting to € 4,000.00 as provided for by the Private Agreement.

Only candidates who will have paid the whole amount of the Master fees (mentioned on the Rep. Decree n. 1948 Prot. N. 33515 Date 20.04.2017) before the starting date of the Master will be eligible to the assignment of one of the scholarships.

List of documentation to be attached to the application for admission to the Master's programme:

- Application form (www.polidesign.net/en/colordesign/admission);
- Curriculum Vitae;
- Portfolio;
- Self-certification relating to personal identity (name and surname, date and place of birth, nationality and residence);
- Copy of valid passport;
- Photocopy of the academic qualification obtained in addition to a certificate displaying the grades of the individual in the Diploma Exam or Supplement (at the time of enrolment) must be handed over along with the Declaration issued on site by the competent Italian Representation authority abroad as per territory or an attestation issued by the Enic/Naric Centres).

Students are not allowed to combine the scholarships with the partial exemptions made available by POLI.design for the same Master's program or any other scholarships, other exemptions and/or other forms of funding at the Master's degree.

Acceptance of the scholarship is to be considered exclusive.

DEADLINES AND COMMUNICATIONS

The students will be selected in chronological order with respect to the date of payment of deposit amounting to € 4.000,00 as provided for by the Private Agreement, until the scholarships are exhausted.

For the purpose of awarding scholarships, on the day after the start of the Masters programme, POLI.design will submit to the Associazione Italiana Colore, the time-based ranking of the students entitled to scholarships, complete with their names and contact details, indicating the date and time of the deposit registered by the bank of POLI.design as advance payment of € 4.000,00 and balance of the entire participation fee as provided for in article 7 "Taxes and Contributions" of Decree No. 1948 Prot. No. 33515 Date 20.04.2017.

The Associazione Italiana Colore will deliver the scholarship amount to the interested person within 60 days from the start date of the Masters course lessons.

The initiative is valid from 27/11/2017.

By providing the personal data required in the specific application for admission and in the curriculum vitae, the Candidate is aware of the criminal penalties applicable in the case of false statements and is required to provide accurate, complete, correct and truthful data
