INTRODUCTION

Extreme Spaces – Designing for Life in Extreme Environments is an executive course that introduces participants to the design principles and approaches specific to extreme environments, using high-altitude environments as the case study for the first edition.

The course serves as a gateway to a complex and rapidly evolving field, providing an integrated overview of the environmental, behavioral, and systemic dynamics that characterize extreme conditions. Through multidisciplinary contributions from fields such as research, industry, emergency management, and technological innovation, participants will gain a structured understanding of decision-making and operational processes in highly critical contexts.

The program aims to develop a conscious design approach capable of interpreting complexity and transferring methods and tools to various professional fields.

No specialized skills in technical or scientific fields are required.

Basic training in design or technical fields, or equivalent professional experience, is required.

Familiarity with design processes, the management of complex systems, or professional activities in dynamic contexts is recommended.

TARGET AUDIENCE

The course is aimed at planners, architects, designers, professionals, and managers interested in acquiring basic skills and interpretive tools to operate in complex and extreme contexts.

It is particularly suitable for professionals seeking to explore the topic of extreme environments as a field for innovation and professional development, coming from sectors such as design, engineering, project management, innovation, and research.

The course is also designed for professionals in the process of repositioning their careers, interested in developing new cross-functional skills related to managing complexity, resilience, and behavior under extreme conditions.

TEACHING PLAN (45 hours)

THEORETICAL MODULE – Introduction to Extreme Environments

Hours: 2

Delivery method: Online

Description:

This module introduces the concept of extreme environments as complex systems, defining the main risk factors, vulnerabilities, and interactions between the environment and human behavior. High altitude is presented as a case study for the first edition.

Main contents:

- Definition of Extreme Environments
- High altitude as an extreme system
- Vulnerability and risk
- Environment–behavior relationship

THEORETICAL MODULE – Extreme Environments: High Altitude Systems

Hours: 8

Delivery method: Online

Description:

This module explores the context of high altitude through the analysis of real-world scenarios, highlighting environmental conditions, operational challenges, and intervention dynamics.



Main contents:

- Environmental conditions at high altitude
- Operational scenarios
- Risk and safety
- Case studies

THEORETICAL MODULE – Human Behavior & Performance Under Stress

Hours: 8

Delivery method: Online

Description:

Analysis of human behavior under stress through real-world cases, with a focus on performance, decision-making, and cognitive decline.

Main topics:

- Environmental and cognitive stress
- Decision making
- Fatigue and error
- Performance in emergencies

THEORETICAL MODULE – Use & Gesture Design

Hours: 2

Delivery method: Online

Description:

Introduction to the Use & Gesture Design (UGD) methodology, with a focus on the behavioral dimension, operational sequence, and systemic analysis of the project under extreme conditions.

Main topics:

- Gesture and micro-action
- Operational sequence
- Error and adaptation
- UGD framework

THEORETICAL MODULE – Mission Design & Decision Systems

Hours: 8

Delivery method: Online

Description:

This module introduces the principles of mission planning and management in extreme environments, emphasizing the systemic and decision-making aspects.

Main topics:

- Mission planning
- Logistics
- Coordination



- Decision-making systems

THEORETICAL MODULE – Technologies for Extreme Conditions

Hours: 8

Delivery method: Online

Description:

Presentation of technologies and support systems for extreme environments, through concrete examples and application cases.

Main contents:

- Wearable technologies
- Parameter monitoring
- Support systems
- Technological innovation

THEORETICAL MODULE – Extreme Analogues: From Antarctica to Space

Hours: 4

Delivery method: Online

Description:

Analysis of extreme terrestrial environments as analogues to space, with a focus on Antarctica.

Main content:

- Analogue environments
- Isolation and confinement
- Earth-to-space transfer

DESIGN MODULE / WORKSHOP – Extreme Design Lab: High Altitude Scenario

Hours: 5

Delivery method: In-person

Description:

Development of a design scenario related to high altitude, applying the acquired knowledge and constructing a design framework.

Main content:

- Emergency scenario
- Behavioral analysis
- Sequence breakdown
- Design framework

The course consists of 45 hours, for a total of 21 sessions spread over 10 weeks.

- 1 final in-person workshop session (Fridays from 2:00 PM to 7:00 PM) for a total of 5 in-person hours.
